THE OHIO STATEHOUSE EMERGENCY RESPONSE GUIDE









- Pull fire alarm, if possible
- Call 911 or OSHP
- Shut off lights and close doors
- Use fire extinguisher, if possible
- Remain low if encountering smoke
- Give directions to designated evacuation location
- Use stairs, not elevators

- Give directions to designated shelter area
- Shut off lights and close doors
- Go to shelter area or any interior hallway or restroom.
- Stay away from windows
- Remain in shelter until All-Clear notification is made by OSHP

- Call 911 or OSHP
- State who, what, where, when, why and how the situation occurred.
 - Medical Emergency
 - o Suspicious Package
 - Suspicious Activity
 - Suspicious Person
 - o Bomb Threat
- If bomb threat, turn off all electronics
- If cardiac event, locate nearest AED and follow instructions

RUN

- o Have an escape plan
- Quickly move away from threat
- o Leave belongings behind
- Warn others of danger

HIDE

- Hide in an area out of the shooter's view
- Create barriers to prevent or slow down the threat
- o Silence your cell phone

FIGHT

- Be prepared to defend yourself
- Be aggressive and committed to your actions

CALL 911 when you are in a safe area

When law enforcement arrives, show your hands and follow commands
